in relation to a research centre named

RECITALS:

- A. The Commonwealth and the Existing Researcher Parties and the Retiring Researcher Party entered into a Contract dated 16 December 2003 (the "Commonwealth Agreement") and subsequently varied on 30 May 2005 in relation to the Bushfire Cooperative Research Centre.
- B. The parties now wish to amend the Commonwealth Agreement to provide for:
 - **a.** the admission of the New Researcher Party, the University of New South Wales, as a core participant, effective from 1st July 2005 to 30th June 2010;
 - **b.** the retirement of the Retiring Researcher Party, the Australian Building Codes Board, effective from 1st July 2005;
 - **c.** the replacement of Schedule 3 "Budget" Part A Tables 1, 2, 3 and 4 to provide for the contributions from the New Researcher Party; and
 - **d.** the replacement of Schedule 4 "Personnel" to provide for changes in specified personnel, including in particular, the CRC variation agent.

THIS DEED PROVIDES as follows:

1 INTERPRETATION

1.1 In this deed, the following terms apply:

Admission & Retirement of Researcher Parties

"Effective Date" means the 1st July 2005;

"Existing Researcher Parties" means B. Met, BCRC Ltd, CFA, CSIRO, EMA, F&ESA, Uni Melb, Vic DS&E, MF&ES Board, NSW FB, NSW NP&W, NSW RFS, Qld F&R, SF NSW, Tas P&C, UTAS, UWA, Vic S&E, and WADEC;

"New Researcher Party" means UNSW; and

"Retiring Researcher Party" means ABC Board.

1.2 In this deed, unless the contrary intention appears, capitalised terms used which are not defined under clause 1.1 of this deed have the same meaning as in the Commonwealth Agreement.

2 VARIATION TO COMMONWEALTH AGREEMENT

- 2.1 The Commonwealth Agreement is varied as follows:
 - 2.1.1 The New Researcher Party is included as an additional party to the Commonwealth Agreement to be collectively identified as the "Researcher" together with the Existing Researcher Parties.
 - 2.1.2 On and from the Effective Date, the New Researcher Party:
 - warrants that it is familiar with the terms of the Commonwealth Agreement and that it has full capacity to become a party to the Commonwealth Agreement and will not, as at the Effective Date, be in breach of any of its obligations arising under the Commonwealth Agreement; and
 - (b) unconditionally agrees to be bound by the provisions of the Commonwealth Agreement as a party collectively described as the Researcher under the Commonwealth Agreement, including, but not limited to, the express obligations on the Researcher to:
 - (i) carry out the Activities of the Centre;
 - (ii) provide Researcher Contributions;
 - (iii) ensure proper accounting standards and controls are exercised;
 - (iv) provide certain reports to the Commonwealth;
 - (v) maintain appropriate levels of insurance;
 - (vi) indemnify the Commonwealth from unlawful or negligent acts of the Researcher; and
 - (vii) provide access to certain premises and records.
 - 2.1.3 Notwithstanding clause 2.1.2, the Existing Researcher Parties and the Commonwealth acknowledge that, prior to the Effective Date, the New Researcher Party was not a party to the Commonwealth Agreement and, as such, was not subject to any rights and/or liabilities that may have accrued in respect of the parties under that Commonwealth Agreement.
 - 2.1.4 The Retiring Researcher Party warrants to the Commonwealth and to all the parties comprising the Researcher that it has performed all of its obligations under the Commonwealth Agreement up to the Effective Date.
 - 2.1.5 Subject to clause 2.1.4, on and from the Effective Date, the Commonwealth and each of the parties comprising the Researcher agrees to release and forever discharge the Retiring Researcher Party from its obligations under the Commonwealth Agreement.

- 2.1.6 On and from the Effective Date, each of the parties comprising the Researcher, other than the Retiring Researcher Party, agrees to assume any of the obligations of the Retiring Researcher Party which remain unfulfilled on or after the Effective Date of this Deed of Variation under the Commonwealth Agreement.
- 2.1.7 Nothing in this Deed of Variation affects the obligations of the Researcher (including the Retiring Researcher Party) under clause 20 [Indemnity] in the Commonwealth Agreement.
- 2.1.8 Schedule 3, Tables 1, 2, 3 and 4, of the Commonwealth Agreement are respectively replaced with Tables 1, 2, 3 and 4 appearing at Annexure A of this deed.
- 2.1.9 Schedule 4 [PERSONNEL] of the Commonwealth Agreement is replaced with Schedule 4 [PERSONNEL], appearing at Annexure B of this deed.

3 COSTS AND STAMP DUTY

- 3.1 Subject to clause 3.2, each party remains responsible for its own costs for entering into this deed.
- 3.2 All stamp duty (including fines, penalties and interest) which may be payable on or in connection with this deed will be borne by the New Researcher Party. The New Researcher Party indemnifies the other parties to this deed on demand against any liability for that stamp duty.

4 GOVERNING LAW

4.1 This deed is construed in accordance with the law for the time being in force in the Australian Capital Territory.

5 SEVERABILITY

5.1 If a clause or part of a clause of this deed can be read in a way that makes it illegal, unenforceable or invalid, but can also be read in a way that makes it legal, enforceable and valid, it must be read in the latter way. If any clause or part of a clause is illegal, unenforceable or invalid, that clause or part is to be treated as removed from this deed, but the rest of this deed is not affected.

6 COUNTERPARTS

6.1 This deed may be executed in any number of counterparts. All counterparts together will be taken to constitute one (1) document.
